CHAMPION LEADERS PROGRAM (CLP)

- Prepares adults to answer the call to leadership and to positively influence others in the home, church, marketplace, and the throughout the world
- Length of Program: 9- 12 Months & Practicum
- Certification of Completion upon successful Completion of the Program Course Requirements
- Text **CLP** to (833)321-3222
- Completion of the CLA Program Application is required

CHAMPION MINISTRY PREPARATION PROGRAM (CMPP)

- Prepares and equips adults who are called to dedicate their lives to serve the Lord
- Students are prepared to minister locally and throughout the world
- Length of Program: 24 months & Internship
- CLA Liaison Discipleship Relationship offered
- Program completion may result in a Certificate of Completion or Licensure

The Champion Ministry Preparation Program (CMPP) is designed to assist men and women to discern and to declare their call to ministry. We offer two Tracks within the CMPP:

Track I: Certification

Track II: Licensure to Preach the Gospel

CMPP Certification Track

The Champion Ministry Preparation Program Certification Track provides a Biblical education which teaches students how to apply scripture in their daily walk and use their spiritual gifts. Successful completion of the CMPP may result in a Certificate of Completion.

CMPP Licensure Track

The Champion Ministry Preparation Licensure Track prepares students to preach the Gospel as he/she has opportunity and to exercise their spiritual gifts in the work of ministry. Ministry Licensure is based upon successful completion of the CMPP and the decision for Licensure made by the Office of the Bishop of Faithful Central Bible Church.

CHAMPION PASTORS PROGRAM (CPP)

- A customized track based on a person's call to Pastoral Ministry
- Offers and assigns Peer-to-Peer Discipleship and Mentorship
- Designed for current Pastors and Seminary Students

CLA COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Provided is a list of courses and descriptions. Courses are offered periodically during the Spring, Summer, and Fall Semesters.

Believe-Know What You Believe

This class provides an overview of ten key Christian doctrines. The objective of this class is to equip you with fundamental Biblical truths, how to defend the Christian faith, along with facilitating a forum for theological questions and answers.

Biblical Counseling

This class is a general introduction to Biblical counseling that is designed to offer a Christ-centered approach to soul care that relies upon the sufficiency of Scripture and the guidance of the Holy Spirit. The course is designed to present an overview of what biblical counseling is along with the ethics, skills and methods to meet the needs of others. It will also present basic counseling methodology with special attention given to laying a biblical foundation for the counseling ministry and how it can transform lives.

Christian Doctrine

This class introduces the student to theology and the fundamental beliefs of Christianity. Emphasis is placed on understanding the fundamental beliefs the Christian has, the nature of God, and our relationship with Him. The class integrates various fields of knowledge and the need for students to recognize the importance of having a Christian worldview.

Gifted-Discover Your God Given Spiritual Gifts

This class is an exciting class that helps you discover your spiritual gifts, what the Bible says about spiritual gifts, and how to use your gifts in every area of your life. The GIFTED class empowers you to live life on purpose!

Health and Wellness

The Health and Wellness workshops are interactive and designed to help students learn the importance of caring for their mind, body, and soul. The workshops emphasize 1 Corinthians 6:19, "Your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit". There are a variety of topics including healthy & balanced living, self-care, and lifestyle choices.

Holy Sacraments

This workshop will educate, instruct, and model servanthood while demonstrating eight sacraments conducted as an act of worship and include... Baby Dedication, Baptism, Funerals, Graveside Committals, Holy Communion, House Blessing, The Altar Invitation, and Visitation.

How To Interpret The Bible (Hermeneutics)

This class focuses on equipping to interpret and apply the Bible in accurate and dynamic ways for spiritual transformation and character formation.

Interpersonal Relationships

This course focuses on managing the complexities of relational dynamics in various contexts, conflict resolution, and how to do so from a Biblical perspective.

The Intersection of Faith and Career

This course empowers leaders who are representatives of the Kingdom of God in the marketplace, careers, and ministry while displaying God's grace for Discipleship to occur. This course focuses on the marketplace leader and will provide tools that inspire, teach, and connect leaders to resources and relationships from a Christian perspective.

Leadership-There is a Champion Leader In You!

This class encourages students to positively influence and motivate others in their sphere of influence. Students will learn how to apply Biblical principles and internalize habits that result in effective leadership skills that prove fair, honest, considerate, and compassionate.

Learning While Serving Internship & Practicum

The Learning While Serving Internship or Practicum is designed to give serving experiences and practical application of CLA courses. Preapproved areas of service include ministerial and professional locations. It is an opportunity to deepen the student's connection with the church and to form new relationships within the body of Christ at Faithful Central Bible Church and abroad.

New Testament History & Literature

The New Testament History & Literature class is an overview of the New Testament with emphasis on the purpose of the writers, historical and cultural background, literary genre, structure, and themes, persons involved, together with practical application to Christian living.

Old Testament History & Literature

This course is an overview of the Old Testament with emphases on the purpose and perspective of the writers, history and culture, literary genre, structure, and themes; character and events, together with practical application for modern Christian living. This course is designed to assist students in acquiring a proper foundation in the Old Testament.

Organizational Leadership

This course focuses on the process of leadership which involves the leader, the followers and the organizational and administrative processes involved in leading others. A variety of leadership topics such as organizational behavior, decision-making and team building are included.

Sermon Preparation (Homiletics)

This class discusses best practices for preparing a sermon and tactics for effective delivery. Outcomes include evidence of a solid knowledge of Scripture, the correct use of hermeneutics and the ability to communicate the Gospel message orally and in written form.

Spiritual Formation-A Deeper Dive Into Intimacy With God

This course focuses on the indwelling work of the Holy Spirit. Here, we learn to understand our family of origin, our relationships, our theological outlook, our experiences and our native tendencies from a biblical perspective and how they have contributed to our journey of faith. This study is fundamental to our personal spiritual transformation and discipleship to others.

Stewardship

This course teaches students how to manage their time, talent & treasure God's way. Students learn biblical stewardship principles and how to edify others by using good stewardship with an emphasis on Christ-like character. Students learn and apply Biblical, spiritual, and practical stewardship principles for use during effective leadership.

Theology I

This class teaches the Biblical doctrines of God, Christ, man, and sin, with reference to the history and development of Christian theology.

Theology II

This class teaches Biblical doctrines of salvation, the Holy Spirit, the church, and last things, with reference to the history and development of Christian theology
